**BULLETIN BOARD DECORATION**

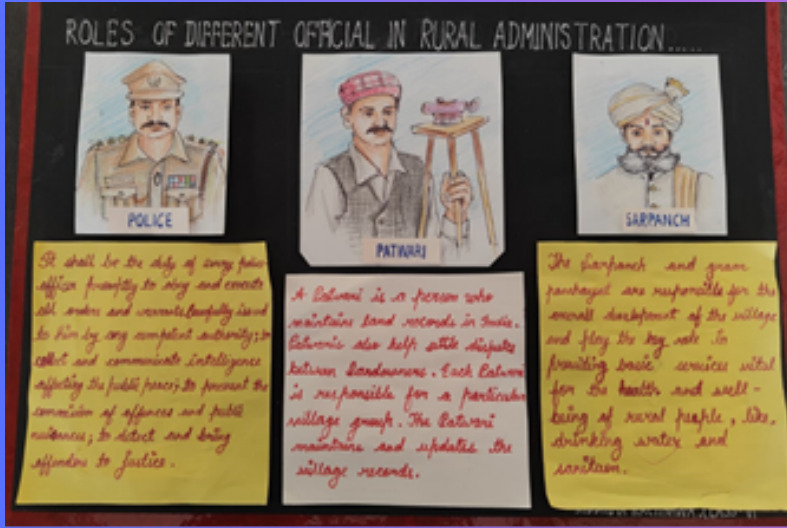
**“CELEBRATE THE SPIRIT OF NAVRATRI, ILLUMINATE THE JOY OF DIWALI”!**

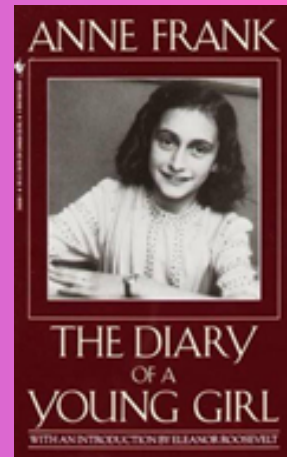
